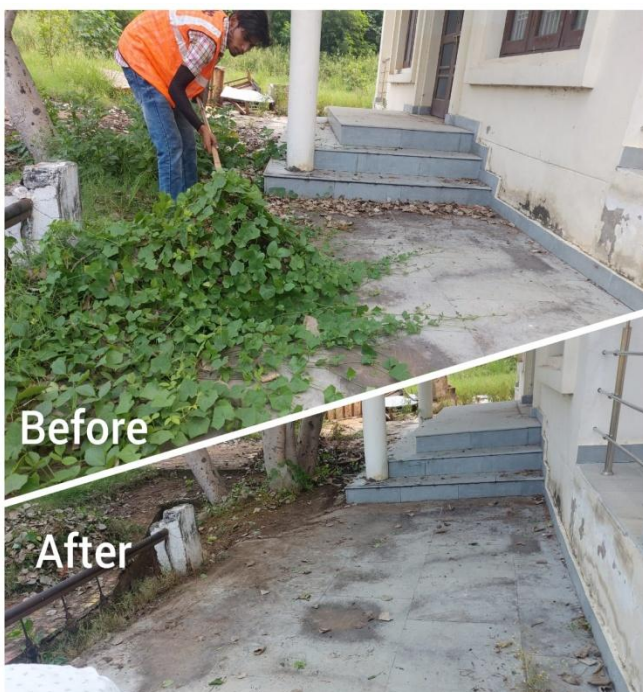
Cleanliness Drive Under “Swachhata Pakhwada- 2021”

Anti Plastic campaign initiated by JMC called Bye - Bye Plastic **#jammuagainstplastic**

In its continuous efforts to discourage the use of polythene, JMC has launched a comprehensive campaign, named Bye-Bye plastic with the aim to completely stop usage of single use plastic/ polythene in Jammu city.

Under this initiative, Eight (8) numbers of Kiosks were installed in the prominent areas of Jammu City viz Karan Nagar, Rehari Colony Chowk, Patoli, Rajpura & Shakti Nagar at Rehari Colony and Sabzi Mandi, Bahu Plaza & Nanak Nagar at Gol Market, Gandhi Nagar on Tuesday 05.10.2021, where useful information was shared regarding the ill effects of the usage of Plastic. Besides, these Kiosks will function as exchange points for Single use plastic/ polythene with that of Cloth/ Jute Bag. General public was encouraged to use Jute/ Cloth Bag for carrying daily provisions and goods. Shopkeepers will also be made aware of various aspects and provisions of Plastic Waste Management Rules 2021 and would be motivated to stop using of Polythene Bags/ Single use plastic.

JMC launches sanitation drive for heritage place in Jammu.

The Commissioner, JMC while speaking on the occasion stated that the aim of launching sanitation drive is to give extra focus in sanitation point of view and Mubarak Mandi has been chosen for today's sanitation drive, as this is a iconic monument of the Jammu City and cleaning this monument will spread the message among the general masses the importance of sanitation. She added that JMC shall continue with such sanitation drives wherein other iconic spots of the city shall be undertaken for sanitation and better upkeep.



She further stated that JMC is providing sanitation in the entire city and putting every possible effort to provide upto mark sanitation in its area of jurisdiction. The aim of launching this special sanitation drive is to take up iconic and heritage places of the city. Directions have already given to the sanitation staff for putting their every possible effort for providing proper sanitation to the citizens of the Jammu City, as the aim for launching this speical sanitation drive is to ensure higher cleanliness at the door steps.

The Commissioner appealed to the people to cooperate with Jammu Municipal Corporation and use identified places for disposal of garbage. She also stressed to avoid use of polythene to the extent possible which is the major cause of blockage of drains and nallahs. She stressed for putting every possible efforts in achieving goal of making city Jammu Clean & Green and aim of Swachh Bharat Mission.

Jammu Municipal Corporation conducts a fogging drive by covering every nook and corner of the Jammu city to stop spreading of Dengue

To further intensify the ongoing fogging drive, JMC has been covering each area falling within its jurisdiction keeping in view the increasing cases of dengue in Jammu city as per the directions of commissioner, Jammu Municipal Corporation and under overall supervision of Health Officer, as per the daily schedule prepared for the purpose. The drives are being undertaken with the cooperation of Anti malaria wing.

Commissioner, JMC Ms. Avny Lavasa (IAS) has issued clear cut directions to health wing of JMC to put in place the sufficient number of men and machinery so that every nook and corner of the city can be covered in respect of fogging to avoid the chances of dengue, as cases of Dengue are on the higher sides in Jammu. The aim of launching fogging drive is to eradicate the breeding of mosquitoes responsible of dengue.

The inhabitants as well as different market associations appreciated the efforts of JMC and also assured their whole hearted cooperation to JMC to undertake such kinds of activities/ drives to make Jammu Dengue free.

The Commissioner appealed the general public to come forward and extend their helping hands to JMC so that Dengue can be eradicated from Jammu and also added that residents should pay attention that waste water should not be accumulated which is a main cause of Dengue.
